Malware

Malicious software designed to damage and control a device to steal information

Multi-factor authentication (MFA)

A tactic that adds an extra layer of security to access accounts and devices



Passphrase

A complex password that uses 4+ random words and 15+ characters long

Phishing

Fraudulent messages disguised as legitimate senders to trick people into sending personal information or money

Ransomware

A type of malware that locks access to files and systems then demands payment to unlock them

Virtual private network (VPN)

A secure connection that allows users to send and receive data securely when using public Wi-Fi
